- Candidates who have applied for multiple courses under 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice preferences across different categories are required to sit for the entrance examination in each applicable category based on their selected preferences. Please refer to the relevant tables for detailed information regarding examination schedules for the respective categories.
- Priority will be given to candidates who have selected the course as their first choice during the selection process. Second and third choices will only be considered if there are vacant seats available in the relevant courses. (Candidate will be shortlisted for his/her highest order of choice based on the results of the aptitude test)
